



FELINE FUND - 2009 APPLICATION FOR FUNDING

Animal Aide Outaouais (AAO) is a registered non-profit organization dedicated to eliminating pet overpopulation and promoting the welfare of companion animals through direct support for the care and spaying/neutering of cats and dogs as well as through education, advocacy and networking.

To this effect the Feline Fund has been set-up to help control the population of stray and feral cats in the Outaouais region. Please note that while every effort will be made to accommodate funding requests, AAO reserves the right to refuse the request for reimbursement in whole or in part, if the following conditions are not met or when the Feline Fund is depleted.

Conditions:

- The funds are to be used solely for the spay and neuter of stray or feral cats.
- Funding will be provided for up to a maximum of \$100.00 for a female cat and up to \$70.00 for a male cat in the case of reimbursement of expenses, or
- A coupon covering the cost of the sterilization will be provided to be used at a local veterinary clinic.
